JUDGMENT AND COMMITMENT/PROBATION ORDER

The above-named defendant having entered a plea of Not Guilty Guilty to the Charge(s) of
(3) obstructing & preventing entry w/ reports/request for assist
(4) att. threats (5) destruction of property

and having been found guilty by Jury Court, it is hereby ORDERED that the defendant has been convicted of
and is guilty of the offense(s) charged, and is hereby SENTENCED to as to counts (3)(4) and (5)

180 days on each count to run consecutively to each other, & S.S. as to all; (2) two years supervised probation with conditions, stayaway in contact with Nicolas Demopoulos; enter and complete 40 hours of community service and D.I.P. maintain after care program for alcohol and drug dependency

MANDATORY MINIMUM term of until completion applies to the sentence imposed

MANDATORY MINIMUM term does not apply.

ORDERED that the defendant be committed to the custody of the Attorney General for imprisonment for the period imposed above.

ORDERED that the defendant be committed to the custody of the Attorney General for treatment and supervision provided by the D.C. Department of Corrections pursuant to Title 24, Section 903[b] of the D.C. Code [Youth Rehabilitation Act 1985].

ORDERED that the defendant be placed on probation in charge of the Director, Social Services Division, and it is further ORDERED that while on probation the defendant observe the following marked conditions of probation:

- Observe the general conditions of probation listed on the back of this order.
- Cooperate in seeking and accepting medical, psychological or psychiatric treatment in accordance with written notice from your Probation Officer.
- Treatment for alcohol problems drug dependency or abuse as follows:
- Restitution of \$ _____ in monthly installments of \$ _____ beginning _____ (see reverse side for payment instructions.)
- The Court will distribute monies to _____
