I was contacted by Brad Paisley on September 18th, 2012 and advised me that he had been scammed by a female (later identified as Hope Lyn Jackson). Mr. Paisley also stated that the woman he and his wife had been corresponding with had told them that she had a daughter that was dying of cancer. She led them to believe this was true by sending them emails and photographs that she had actually used from other websites of actual children that were in fact sick and/or dying. He also told me that she had asked him if he would call her dying daughter and sing the song "Amazing Grace" to her over the telephone and he did. However upon further investigation it was determined that it was not her dying daughter, it was actually Hope Jackson he sang the song to.


Upon further investigation it was determined that the IP address that Hope Jackson had been using was in the area of 2nd and Walnut and that is the location of the La bonte Hotel where Hope Jackson was residing at the time of her arrest.

While conducting my investigation I spoke with Hope Jackson and she stated to me that she knowingly made up the story about her having a dying daughter and that she used photographs that she had found on various websites on the internet to commit this and other scams on unsuspecting people. She stated that she had been conducting this type of activity for at least 4 or 5 years. She also stated that there were other victims.

I spoke with Mr. Paisley and he told me that if he would actually sing to someone for a charity event the bidding would start no less than \$5,000.00

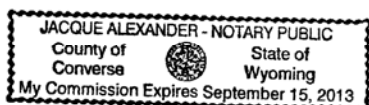
The above facts constitute probable cause for the Defendant's warrantless arrest.
