

1 MR. PEASLEY: Your Honor, as the court may  
2 recall, this case comes before the court with Ms.  
3 Jackson having pled guilty to a charge of theft of  
4 services under 6-3-408.

5 The state and the defense have come to an  
6 agreed disposition in this case, which includes a  
7 guilty plea and a 301 deferral.

8 After reviewing the PSI and having conversa-  
9 tions with the victims, Your Honor, the state  
10 believes this is an appropriate disposition in this  
11 case. The concern for the state, as reflected in  
12 the PSI, stem from the defendant's mental and  
13 emotional condition.

14 As reflected on page seven of the PSI, the  
15 psychological evaluation indicates that the  
16 defendant does in fact need treatment and that  
17 treatment, it appears, stems from both the physician  
18 for her medication and relative to depression and  
19 individual psychotherapy to address the underlying  
20 problems and changing her behavior.

21 As indicated, again on page seven, paragraph  
22 four, recommends an extended period of probation.

23 In addition to the terms and conditions that  
24 the probation and parole officer has provided on  
25 page 11, which is sort of our standard terms and
