MR. PEASLEY: Your Honor, as the court may recall, this case comes before the court with Ms. Jackson having pled guilty to a charge of theft of services under 6-3-408.

The state and the defense have come to an agreed disposition in this case, which includes a guilty plea and a 301 deferral.

After reviewing the PSI and having conversations with the victims, Your Honor, the state believes this is an appropriate disposition in this case. The concern for the state, as reflected in the PSI, stem from the defendant's mental and emotional condition.

As reflected on page seven of the PSI, the psychological evaluation indicates that the defendant does in fact need treatment and that treatment, it appears, stems from both the physician for her medication and relative to depression and individual psychotherapy to address the underlying problems and changing her behavior.

As indicated, again on page seven, paragraph four, recommends an extended period of probation.
